



Information checklist for IBD patients

This checklist is for you. It contains prompts and reminders so you can make sure you receive all the information that you require at your next clinic appointment. You can take it with you to your appointment if it is helpful to you.

Before your appointment

Have you been given a patient information pack or booklet?	Yes No - ask for this to be provided at your next appointment
Have you thought of questions you would like to ask at your appointment? It may be helpful to note these down.	Yes No
Do you have the contact details for your local support group?	Yes No – ask at your next appointment for details of local support services
Do you have details of who you should contact if you have any concerns or if your condition changes?	Yes No – ask at your next appointment who your key contact should be
Are you confident in recognising symptoms of a flare-up?	Yes No – discuss at your next appointment
Do you know what you should do if you think you are beginning to experience a flare-up?	Yes No – discuss at your next appointment
Have you had any difficulties in taking your IBD medicines?	Yes – raise any issues at your appointment No





Have you had any blood tests recently or been asked to hand in any stool samples in preparation for your appointment?	Yes No – ask at your appointment whether you need to do these
If applicable, do you know when your next surveillance colonoscopy is due?	Yes No – ask at your appointment about your surveillance colonoscopy date

Do you fully understand everything that was discussed at your appointment?	Yes No – contact your consultant or nurse with any questions you have
